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# **Opening Remarks and Finances**

Since I issued Battalion Runner 24-1 this past May some very good and some not so good things have happened. The very best thing is donations that came in have basically eliminated our financial crisis for this year. Another good thing is I received donations from several members who had not, at least in my old and degrading memory, contributed before. Good thing number three is we have enough funding to fully support Reunion 2024, including paying for dinner and everything else. That means, as has been the case for several years, the only expense anyone coming to the reunion must incur is getting there and paying for your room and parking. All reunion agenda items, hospitality room food and beverages, our jam session, and transportation to events, are going to be provided at no charge. This includes anyone living locally who wants to participate in any of our events or stops by the hotel to shoot the breeze with other Marines in the hospitality room.

Now the not so good news. While donations have been good enough to temporarily resolve our financing issues, they will not cover expenses for future years. We certainly have enough to cover this year's reunion and costs for running the 2/9 Network website through 2024. Not so good news item two is, I've only received donations from 45 people and some of them donated multiple times or a sizeable amount. I am mentioning that since it carries serious meaning. I have consistently said over the years that any amount donated is a good donation, and that is still true. However, we cannot expect the same people to keep donating large amounts of money to pay for everyone else. I noted in the May newsletter that I have been receiving donations annually from around 70 people out of over 1,200 receiving the newsletter. With that number at 45 as of this newsletter so far this year the future could still be a major issue for the 2/9 Network. Please consider a donation of any amount to keep us going! I hope you all noted that I said these two items are "not so good" news. I did not say they are bad news, but it would be great to be able to say in the next newsletter that more have contributed to keep 2/9's legacy alive well into the future.

# Room Reservation and Parking Information at the Residence Inn

Room Reservations: Our contract has rooms available from 06 through 12 November. The hotel has once again set up a unique reservation page for our members. Book Your Group/Corporate Rate | Marriott International You can also call them at 1-800-331-3131, but be sure to tell them you are making them under the 2/9 Reunion package.

Cut off date for reservations is close of business on 11 October 2024. If you don't have a room booked by then you will have to pay the going rate, and that is more than \$250 per night. If you have problems making a reservation email the Residence Inn sales office at <a href="mailto:sales@rirva.com">sales@rirva.com</a> and explain your problem. The staff will be very glad to help. If that does not work email me at <a href="mailto:twoninencoic@aol.com">twoninencoic@aol.com</a> and I'll try to help.

Not so good news is that as of one week ago there were only 10 rooms reserved for Marines going to the reunion. We usually have between 50-75 at least. Please get your reservations made. I received the reservation listings from the hotel 4-5 times up to the reunion so I know about how many people we'll have, and can get in contact with some who forget to tell me about their dinner plans.

Parking at the hotel: Normal parking rates at the hotel are \$29 per night. Our contract includes a clause that gets us a 50% discount on parking, so it will be \$14.50 per night. The garage accommodates almost all SUVs and pickup trucks, but there is a height limit. Be sure you know you can get through the garage door.
